COVID-19
Operating Guidelines rev 5/13/20
(Subject to changed or altered without notice)

WHAT WE ARE DOING AT THE FLEA MARKET:

- We will require all of our staff to stay home if they have any symptoms or are not feeling well.
- All of our staff will wear masks or facial coverings.
- All of our staff will wear gloves when required.
- We will be conducting increased cleaning procedures of all high touch areas including the restrooms.
- Our restroom capacity will be reduced by 50%.
 - Social distance guidelines put in place for lines, stalls, urinals etc.
- We will be providing Regular, Handicap accessible, and Family Porta Potty's.
- We will provide handwashing access and supplies in the restrooms.
- We are providing hand sanitizer at all entry points of the buildings and food service, including restrooms.
- We will provide a hand sanitizing station that is social distanced for those who need to use it.
- We will provide a disinfecting wipes at the hand sanitizing station for those who wish to wipe down their purchases, or other uses etc.
- Concession stand will be social distanced every 6 feet and limited to only so many people at a time.
 - We are adding online ordering with texting alert when order is ready for pick up, with designated pick up area.
- Vendors will be asked to separate every other space so there is a 20 foot separation in between and asked to set up in single rows facing the screen so that shoppers have an approximate 22 foot aisle way to maneuver around each other, instead of the normal double rows facing each other. Vendors will be allowed to set up on both gravel lots at every other space single row.
- The general public will be asked to put on a mask or facial covering anytime they need to interact directly with our staff, and it is highly recommended that they put on one anytime they interact with vendors or other customers.
- Flea Market provides one entry point and one exit point and they will be strictly enforced, and everyone will be forced to use.
- We will be providing our own staff security and parking to make sure the vendors and shoppers follow the parking procedures laid out.

WHAT WE NEED FROM OUR VENDORS:

- All of our vendors will be required to stay home if they have any symptoms or are not feeling well.
- All vendors will need to wear a mask or facial covering.
- Vendors should provide hand sanitizer & disinfecting wipes if they are able, the Flea Market will have a hand sanitizing station with disinfecting wipes available for customers, but vendors are encouraged to provide.
- Vendors will be asked to separate every other space so there is a 20 foot separation in between and asked to set up in single rows facing the screen so that shoppers have an approximate 22 foot aisle way to maneuver around each other, instead of the normal double rows facing each other. Vendors will be allowed to set up on both gravel lots at every other space single row.
- Children should be supervised at all times and not go anywhere alone.
- Vendors should place their trash directly in the trash cans and or dumpsters to help avoid exposure to our employees.
- Non Registered Vendors either need to register for our ID card at www.southdrive-in.com or make sure they have a State ID present with them to help lessen the amount of contact and amount of potential spread. If you have our ID card you simply hold it up so we can scan it, if you don't you will swipe your ID so we have your name and address and you will provide a phone number just like on the blue non registered daily attendance form you fill out, these forms are being temporarily suspended to prevent contact and lessen the spread.

WHAT WE NEED FROM OUR CUSTOMERS:

- All of our shoppers SHOULD STAY home if they are experiencing ANY SYMPTOMS or are NOT feeling well.
- Shopper are highly recommended to wear a mask or facial covering when visiting the Flea Market.
- Masks or facial coverings will be required when entering the restrooms or concessions, patio, and hand sanitizing, disinfect wipe areas.
- Children should be supervised at all times and not go anywhere alone.
- Shoppers should place their trash directly in the trash cans and or dumpsters to help avoid exposure to our employees.
- Shoppers will be asked to park in the outlying grass fields, as we will be using the previous shopper parking area for vendors.
